Noteworthy Policies, Rules and Regulations from SSCSD Titles

7 - 1 - 7

Interruptions In Service: The District shall not be liable for damage which may result from an interruption in service from a cause beyond the control of the water department. Temporary shutdowns may be made by the water department to make improvements and repairs. Whenever possible and as time permits, all customers affected will be notified prior to making such shutdowns. The District will not be liable for interruption, shortage or insufficiency of supply, or for any loss or damage occasioned thereby, if caused by accident, act of God, fire, strikes, riots, war or any other cause not within its control.

11 - 1 - 3

- A. All vehicles and individuals, dropping refuse at the Stallion Springs Transfer Station, shall display a current SSCSD decal or an authorized non-resident trash disposal card.
- B. Prior approval from the District office may be given to individuals requesting authorization to dump approved refuse using a vehicle without a decal or card.
- C. Commercial Users: Commercial users are not permitted to utilize the facilities provided by the Stallion Springs CSD to dispose of trash, garbage, green waste or any other materials.

The Stallion Springs Transfer Station is for the legal disposal of regular household trash and green waste only.

No Hazardous Materials including paint, paint products, pesticides, solvents, photo and printing chemicals, swimming pool/spa chemicals, asbestos, roofing/road tar, bleach, ammonia, used motor oil, car batteries, industrial waste.

No Building Materials including wood, concrete, drywall, brick, stone, mortar, roofing material.

No Appliances including refrigerators, dishwashers, washing machines, clothes dryers, stoves, ovens, hot water heaters.

No Furniture including couches, chairs, tables, beds, mattresses, box springs, cabinets.

No Electronic Waste including television sets, computers, monitors, virtually anything with a cord.

No Tires. No carpet and padding. No lawn mowers. No Automotive Parts. No Internal Combustion Engines. No Dead Animals. No earth/Dirt.

NOTICE: The Stallion Springs CSD sponsors Community Clean Up Days twice a year (May and October). Residents can dispose of Furniture, E-Waste, Household Appliances and Green Waste at these events.
