Waste Management and Stallion Springs Community Services District are proud to present you with this residential waste service guide.

### Household Waste Disposal

Stallion Springs residents can properly dispose of household trash at the transfer station located at **28500 Stallion Springs Drive**. A Stallion Springs CSD issued vehicle sticker is required to access the trash containers. Stickers can be obtained at the CSD office.

**Note: Bulky items (such as furniture, mattresses, appliances), tires, electronic waste, construction and demolition debris (C&D), household hazardous waste (HHW) [paint, motor oil, chemicals, batteries] and waste from commercial sources will NOT be accepted. Please take these items to the Tehachapi Landfill or a HHW collection center or event.**



### Bulky Items

Residents can drop off most bulky items at the Tehachapi Landfill (12001 East Tehachapi Boulevard) at no charge. This includes: furniture, mattresses, appliances and electronic waste. Other items, such as construction and demolition (C&D) debris and tires are accepted for a fee. Visit **KernPublicWorks.com** for hours and rates.



### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Residents can properly dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) items at one of Kern County's Special Waste Facilities or Collection Events:

##### Mojave Special Waste Facility

17035 Finin Street (southwest corner of Finin & Sabovich Streets on the Mojave Airport property)

**Hours:** 1st Saturday of every other month  
9:00 am – Noon (January, March, May, July, September, November)

**Monthly One-Day HHW Collection Events are held at the Tehachapi Landfill (12001 E. Tehachapi Blvd.).**

- Pesticides
- Photo and printing chemicals
- Roofing tar
- Solvents
- Swimming pool chemicals
- Used vehicle oil

### Building Materials:

- Brick
- Concrete
- Drywall
- Mortar

- Wood



### Appliances:

- Dishwashers
- Dryers
- Hot water heaters
- Refrigerators

- Beds, including mattresses, box springs, frames
