A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE STALLION SPRINGS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE GRANT APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, AND EXECUTION FOR THE STALLION SPRINGS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT SAFE POTABLE WATER PROJECT

Resolution No. 2022-18

WHEREAS, Stallion Springs Community Services District proposes to implement Stallion Springs Community Services District Safe Potable Water Project;

WHEREAS, Stallion Springs Community Services District Safe Potable Water Project is being implemented in response to a drought scenario, as defined by Water Code section 13198(a) and is intended to: (1) address immediate impacts on human health and safety; (2) address immediate impacts on fish and wildlife resources; or, (3) provide water to persons or communities that lose or are threatened with the loss or contamination of water supplies;

WHEREAS, Stallion Springs Community Services District has the legal authority and is authorized to enter into a funding agreement with the State of California; and

WHEREAS, Stallion Springs Community Services District intends to apply for grant funding from the California Department of Water Resources for the Stallion Springs Community Services District Safe Potable Water Project;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Stallion Springs Community Services District as follows:

- 1. That pursuant and subject to all the terms and provisions of Budget Act of 2021, as amended (Stats. 2022, ch. 44, § 25), the Stallion Springs Community Services District General Manager, Vanessa Stevens, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application for funding with the Department of Water Resources and take such other actions as necessary or appropriate to obtain grant funding.
- 2. The Stallion Springs Community Services District General Manager, Vanessa Stevens, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute the funding agreement with the Department of Water Resources and any amendments thereto.
- 3. The Stallion Springs Community Services District General Manager, Vanessa Stevens, or designee is hereby authorized and directed to submit any required documents, invoices, and reports required to obtain grant funding.
