- Continuing to work with David on moving forward with the long list of current projects. He continues to be supportive and informative in all that we do and it is greatly appreciated.
- Discharge has begun in to the recharge basin for Tehachapi Cummings Water District. Carbon filters will begin to filter this week. Thank you to Grimmway for running the pipe needed to make this happen.
- The gymnasium floor work has begun and I am excited to see the finished work.
- Met with the Kern County Rep and Waste Management to finalize the transfer site project before it begins.
- Still waiting for the final delivery date and cost of the fish for Horsethief Lake.
- Daily Operations calls with the CDC and Kern County Public Health regarding the COVID-19 Updates.
- Re-opened all Park Playgrounds, Parks and restrooms, and started staff on the daily sanitizing routine to meet the recommendations from the CDC.
- James Pack completed the smoke test on several streets and found two sewer infiltrations. Contacted residents to correct the issue.
- Followed up with Georgiana Armstrong about the Generator we have been approved for in the Power Safety Shut Offs, hoping for delivery soon.
- Signed documents needed to get the grant awarded Portable Battery units for the Power Shut offs to assist with those with medical conditions.
- Met with CG Systems, Jason and field staff on final layout of the Transfer Site. Things are moving forward.
- The chipper was delivered this week and we will be moving forward to get the green waste site operating ASAP. Getting this site operating sooner will allow the District to start saving money on bins.
- Met with AL and the field staff and started some new protocols to keep our current projects on task.
- The property on Pelliser has been painted, some repairs made and is almost ready for the library to move in.

- I have had several meetings with library volunteers on the layout and operations once they open.
- Worked with the OJT Rep and Linda to get the program back on track after the temporary layoff due to the virus.
- The weeds have grown like crazy!! We will notify the residents this week and begin spraying the week of May 25th.
