(Elections Code Section: 12112, 10510)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held in the following Districts on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of electing:

Governing Board Members in the following School District: (Candidates must be registered voters residing within the District.)

Tehachapi Unified School District

Directors in the following Special Districts: (Candidates must be a resident elector within the Division of the District.)

Bear Valley Community Services District  
Golden Hills Community Services District  
Mountain Meadows Community Services District  
Stallion Springs Community Services District  
Tehachapi Valley Health Care District  
Tehachapi-Cummings Water District

Declarations of Candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the elective offices may be obtained from the Elections Office, 1115 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield, CA 93301. Declarations shall be available commencing on July 16, 2018, 113 days before the election, and shall be filed with the Elections Office in person not later than 5:00 p.m., August 10, 2018, the 88th day before the election. Current law requires all candidates to file a Statement of Economic Interest (Form 700) with the county elections office where they file their declaration of candidacy. These forms are due no later than the final filing date for the declaration of candidacy. The form can be found on the FPPC website ([www.fppc.ca.gov](http://www.fppc.ca.gov)), or is available at the Elections Office. IN ADDITION, Declarations of Candidacy papers may be obtained at the Mojave Administration Building, 1775 Highway 58, Mojave, on July 24, 2018 and July 31, 2018 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

In the event there are no nominees or an insufficient number of nominees for each office and a petition for an election is not timely filed, an appointment to such office shall be made pursuant to Elections Code Section 10515.

Each candidate for nonpartisan elective office may prepare a Candidate's Statement pursuant to Section 13307 of the Elections Code. Such statements may include the name, age, and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications expressed by the candidate. Each statement shall be included in the Sample Ballot, which is mailed to each voter.

Each candidate filing a statement will be required to pay in advance their pro rata share as a condition of having their statement included in the Sample Ballot.
