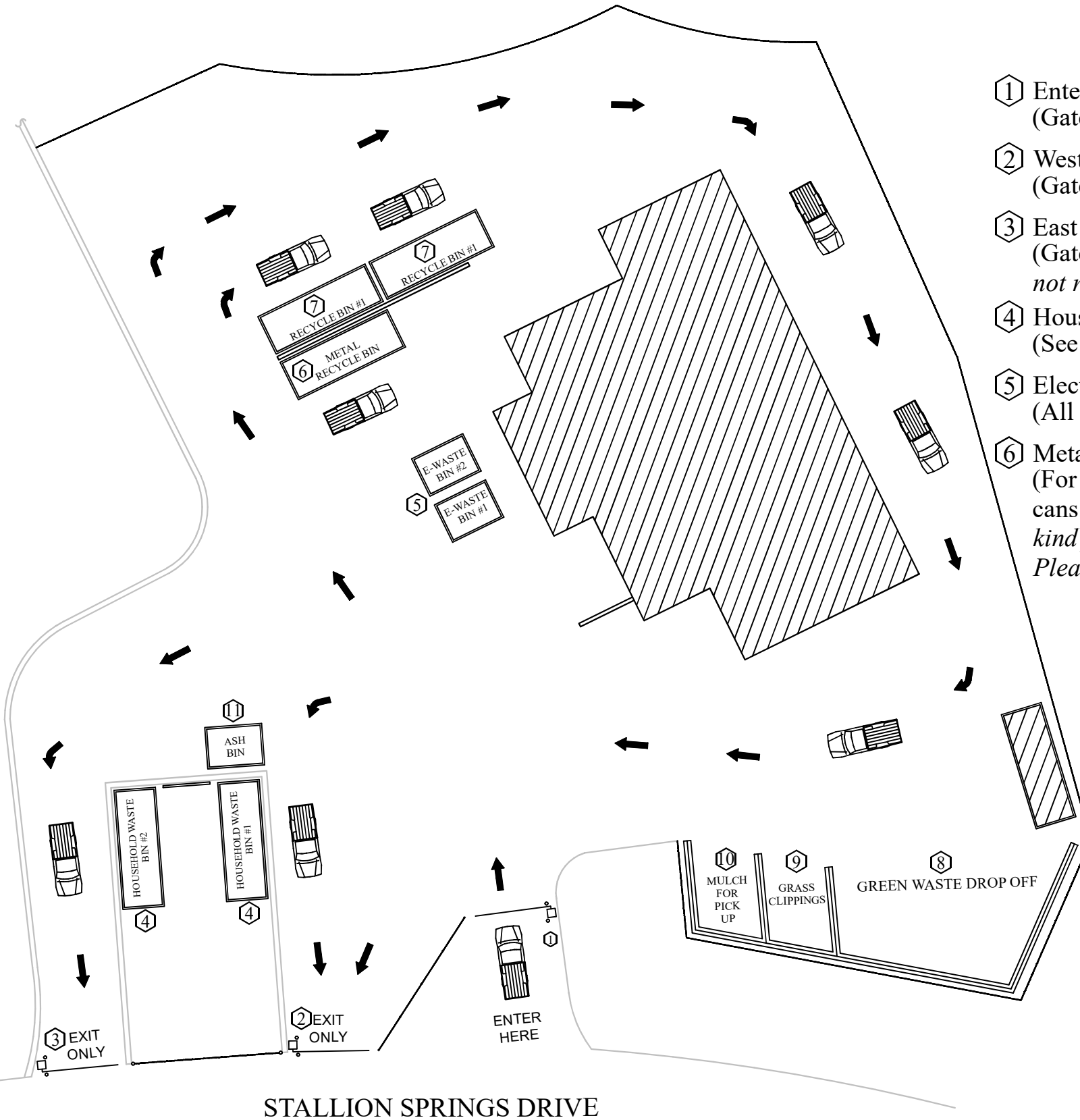


## SSCSD WASTE SITE NOTES



- ① Enter waste site here.  
(Gate will open automatically).
- ② West Side Exit for waste site here.  
(Gate will open automatically).
- ③ East Side Exit for waste site here.  
(Gate will open automatically. *Low vehicles not recommended at East Side Exit*).
- ④ Household waste bins.  
(See attached list of prohibited items for these bins).
- ⑤ Electronic waste bins.  
(All electronic devices except major appliances).
- ⑥ Metal waste bin.  
(For small amounts of recyclable metal other than cans. *No appliances, BBQs, or machines of any kind*).  
*Please call the CSD with questions.*

- ⑦ Recycle bins.  
(Glass, Metal & Aluminum cans, Paper & Cardboard, Recyclable Plastics. *All boxes must be broken down, All recyclable items must be clean and empty*).
- ⑧ Green waste drop off.  
(For mulchable plant & tree vegetation only. Shrubbery & brush trimmings with branches not over one and one-half inches (1-1/2") in diameter, not exceeding four feet (4') in length. *No Stumps or large logs, No hay or manure*).
- ⑨ Place grass clippings and leaves in this area only.  
(*No earth, rocks, wood, or bags in green waste area*).
- ⑩ Mulch for resident use.  
(Residents may pick up mulch for home use from this area).
- ⑪ Ash bin.  
(Ashes must be cold before discarding).

### KEY ITEMS TO BE AWARE OF WHEN USING THE WASTE SITE

- **Slow Down:** Be aware of cross traffic on Stallion Springs Drive, as well as the trash site.
- The entry/exit gate is automatic, please be patient, it will open and close for one vehicle at a time.
- Review the diagram before coming to the site to know where you need to go.
- Please refer to the attached information on this sheet, and signage on site, for rules & guidance on proper use of the facility.
- Always have items separated prior to coming to the waste site.
- Remember, all recyclables must be clean and empty, cardboard boxes must be broken down flat, & no bags in the recycle bin or the green waste area.
- SSCSD will periodically have bulky waste drop off days for some normally prohibited items, or these items can be taken directly to the Tehachapi Landfill.
- Hazardous materials cannot be accepted at the SSCSD Waste Site. Please visit <https://kernpublicworks.com/hazardous-waste/> for information regarding those types of items.
- Prohibited items found in the waste bins at the land fill will result in fines for our District and a minimum fine of \$100 for the violator(s).
