## WE WANT TO KNOW:

The District staff and Board of Directors are attempting to feel the pulse of the community on various issues. There have been a few meetings with the Property Owners Association, Board of Directors and the General Manager in regard to phasing out the Property Owners Association and forming a 501(c)(3) under the umbrella of the Community Services District. We are still in the discussion stages of this change and the Board of Directors for Stallion Springs will make the ultimate decision, should this idea progress.

The Property Owners Association has been a volunteer group that has accomplished many fine things for the community such as fundraisers and donations toward the good of the community. Over the years, the POA has had difficulty finding enough volunteers to accomplish the various functions done.

A 501(c)(3) under the umbrella of the Stallion Springs Community Services District would provide the ability for the newly formed foundation to still accomplish fund raisers and oversee various events, but would also allow the District staff to interact more with the various events. The newly formed foundation would NOT be charging the \$35 per year in membership dues, but we would HOPE that residents would make tax deductible donations to the foundation. Donations and Fund-raising money toward the foundation would stay in the foundation, and a board that is appointed by the CSD Board of Directors to serve on the foundation would make recommendations on where the money would be best used.

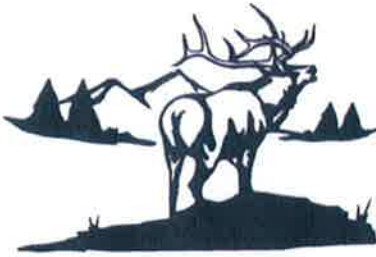

## SSPOA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR 2019

Each year, the Stallion Springs Property Owner's Association (non-profit organization) gives a scholarship to a graduating senior from Tehachapi High School, all other high schools and home schooled students. This has been a tradition of the SSPOA for many years, in the amount of \$1,000 for each qualified senior applicant.

If an applicant(s) is selected from THS, the scholarship(s) will be presented by our SSPOA president at the High School Awards Assembly each year. If the applicant(s) is selected from another high school or someone who is home schooled, the scholarship will be presented at a general meeting or the annual meeting of the SSPOA, the date will be announced.

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, the graduating senior must be current resident of Stallion Springs; have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better; plan to be a full time college student or working and taking at least six units. At the time of presentation, a certificate will be given to the successful applicant(s). The actual scholarship is given in full at the time a proof of college attendance is given or an accredited training program is chosen.

Applicants must submit their qualifications along with an essay expressing: 1) their goals for the future as well as 2) What they love about Stallion Springs and would like to see improved here. All papers are to be submitted to the Tehachapi High School Counseling Secretary in accordance with the guidelines set up by the High School or directly to our President Debbie Rodriguez. All other applicant(s) must submit their essays and a formal GPA document by April 15<sup>th</sup>. The information about all scholarships is disseminated by THS; however, if you know of a graduating boy or girl that is not aware of the availability of this scholarship, please advise them to consult the THS counseling office. We give two or three scholarships each year.
